French Bulldog

Post Graduate D/B (3 entered 2 absent)

1. Kokolus; Lady Sophia – Well marked pied with a well-shaped skull, excellent eye shape, good nose placement and good width of chin. Typical outline with correct top-line. Strong bone and substance. Positive mover, holding a typical shape at all times. Excellent temperament. BOB

Open Dog (2/1)

1. Forsythe; Chivasregal Ines of Islay Ardhub – Fawn with an excellent body shape, excellent bone and good depth of chest. Well placed shoulder and good top-line. Feet could be tighter. A little over-done in head for me but correct shaped and set ears. Moved well, excellent temperament. BOS

Japanese Shiba Inu

Post Graduate D/B (3/2)

1. Best-Rawlings; Tapena No Ryuu Tomadachi at Trixwood – Excellent head and expression, lovely eye and well set and carried ears. Strong pigmentation, well-shaped muzzle. Well balanced outline for size. Excellent tail-set and carriage. Moves well with a light and free action. Excellent feet. Typical temperament. BOB

Open D/B (3/0)

1. Best-Rawlings; Trixwood It's a Kind of Magic to Zaandam – Lovely feminine head with a well-shaped eye and typical expression. Well set ears but needs to use them more. Good outline and moves well, especially in profile. Excellent coat texture and good temperament. BOS
2. Best-Rawlings; Rina Wakimi Del Cazadora Blance at Trixwood – Black & Tan with a lovely head and eye. Excellent outline, well-proportioned for size, good bone and tail carriage. Moved well. Changing coats. Excellent temperament.

Japanese Spitz

Post Graduate D/B (1/0)

1. Marshall; Charney Morning Song for Shandalar – Very attractive head and expression. Excellent pigmentation and well-shaped eye. Good mouth, excellent ear set and carriage. Good bone but a little immature in body. Positive mover with wonderful temperament. Coming in to good coat. BOB

AV Utility NSC

Open D/B (1/0)

1. Greig; Valkira My Happiness at Kildonan (Kooikerhondje) – well-proportioned head, good, dark eye, well set ears. Would prefer a little more neck. Good bone and substance. Well-shaped feet. A little unsettled on the move but a lovely temperament. BAVNSC

AV Imported Register Breeds

Open D/B

1. Main; Tamoanchan Jabari Brave – (Xoloitzcuintle) Well-shaped skull with good eye and strong muzzle. Well-proportioned outline with excellent skin condition. Typical temperament. Moved well. Best AV Import Register.

AV Special Veteran (7-9 years)

1. Donaldson; CH Zorbaloo The Black Ice (Schipperke). Excellent head with typical skull, lovely dark, well-shaped eye, excellent neat ears and typical expression. Lovely bone and in lovely overall condition. Well-constructed and moves well. Excellent coat texture. Super temperament. BEST OVERALL VETERAN
2. Smiths; CH Torfness Scarlet Phancy (Tibetan Spaniel); Well proportioned head, with well cushioned muzzle, lovely dark well-shaped eye and correct ear set and carriage. Strong pigmentation. Well balanced outline for size and balanced construction front and rear. Positive mover and lovely temperament. In good coat.

AV Special Veteran (10+ years)

1. Moir; CH Jansaniels Mayhem (German Spitz Mittel) Excellent type with a lovely head and typical expression. Well-shaped eye, correct skull and excellent muzzle. Well set and carried years. Excellent top-line and bone. Moved well. Just needs a little more coat to complete the picture.
2. Shepherd; Kichigal Lord of the Dance (Keeshond) Excellent, well-proportioned head, with typical expression. Well set and carried ears. Correct coat texture and clear colour. Moved well for age and typical temperament.

BEST IN SHOW

1. Davies; CH Redwitch This Is Me at Shinzam (Akita) – a very impressive masculine dog with an excellent head and wonderful expression. Super balance with just the right amount of bone and substance. Lovely silhouette stood, but he comes in to his own on the move – so sound and well-constructed. In wonderful overall condition.
2. Schuckardt & Schuckardt; Timazinti's Peppermint at Frenchlands; (Lhasa Apso). Another wonderful example of his breed and proving, yet again, the great longevity of these oriental breeds. Lovely, well laid out, typical head and expression with strong pigmentation. Lovely size and balance and well-constructed. Moves well and in excellent coat and over all condition.
3. Grants; CH Silvora Tik Tok (Toy Poodle); Super head and expression with lovely dark, well-shaped eye and excellent chiselling. Good chin. Excellent body shape under a coat of correct texture and good spring of rib and fore chest. Moves well in a very typical manner. Typical temperament.
4. Hargreaves; Karamyst Time to Shine with Islantic (Tibetan Terrier) - Black & white with a lovely, well balanced, square outline and of correct size. Attractive head and eye and typical expression. Moves well and in lovely coat.

BEST PUPPY IN SHOW

1. Brown; Remmus High Class (Tibetan Terrier) – Black with white with a very typical head and expression, super pigmentation and well-shaped eye. At the correct state of development for her age and a lovely square outline. A very confident youngster and moves well.
2. Watt & Bruce; Donaska Tilted Halo (Miniature Poodle) – Black with a gorgeous head, lovely eye and excellent length of foreface. Needs a little more fill in chest but her body shape is super and at the right stage of development for her age. On the move she just “switches it on” and holds a typical shape at all times. Excellent coat condition.
3. Grant; Silvora Amorecano (Toy Poodle) – lovely breed type and wonderful character all wrapped up in a tiny package. In lovely overall condition and super confident on the move.
4. Philip; Dvojica Filthy Gorgeous (Dalmatian) - very attractive head and expression, well-shaped eye and good muzzle. A very well balanced baby, well-constructed front and rear. Lively and active on the move and very nicely decorated.

1. Scott & Scott; Aprika Fargo at Rudino (Boston Terrier) – Excellent head and expression with excellent ear set, size and carriage. Strong, compact body and excellent muscle tone. Excellent top-line and front assembly. Super feet. Typical, outgoing temperament and super energetic.
2. Maxwell & Chalmers; Jodak’s Dance Party at Aintshe (Lhasa Apso) – excellent type and size with lovely bone. Strong pigmentation and well-shaped eye. Moves well and lovely coat texture.

1. Grants; CH Silvora Tik Tok (Toy Poodle); See 3rd Best in Show
2. Christie; Betranna Athos (Tibetan Spaniel) – good masculine head with typical expression, well-shaped eye and excellent chin. Firm top-line and excellent tail-set and carriage. Once settles, moves well. In excellent coat of correct texture.
